Born in England in 1971 to a British mother and a French father, **Nicolas Vadot** spent his childhood in France, before moving to Brussels at the age of 17. He moved to Canberra in 2005, where he currently lives. He's the editorial cartoonist for two major Belgian newspapers: *Le Vif/L'Express*, a weekly newsmagazine in which he started out in 1993, and *L'Echo*, a finance daily for which he's worked since 2008.

Vadot is also the author of several graphic novels in the French-speaking world. His latest book, *Neuf Mois*, was published by Casterman in May 2009.

He has also published a compilation of his cartoons on the Bush presidency, called "*The George W. Bush Years*" (New Holland Australia, 2007).
